### COURSE OVERVIEW

During the course, students will explore the work of a wide range of visual artists and practitioners whose work links to the coursework theme. Students will then create their own personal responses exploring a wide range of fine art techniques and processes, making links to the artist's work they are analysing. Students will resolve their experimentation with a final outcome.
